Authors Instructions

All papers will be reviewed by at least two referees. Articles which are refused for publication will not be returned to the authors. Manuscripts should be written in English and organized in the following manner:

- Title
- Name(s), affiliation(s) of author(s), the address and e-mail for each author and an asterisk to indicate the corresponding author
- Abstract (no more than 150 words)
- Research objectives
- Experimental section (this should contain the usual subsections: introduction, material, methodologies, experimental data, and results)
- Conclusion
- References
- Tables with titles
- Figures with caption
